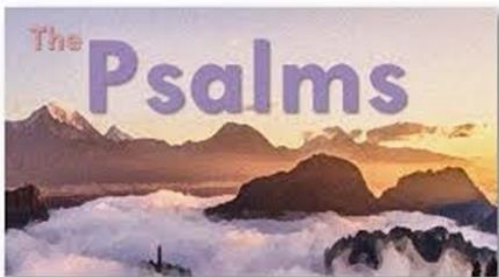
Question: Does Adonai abstain from doing good to us?

Book 2, Psalm 67 speaks of the psalmist prays to Adonai to bless His people so that all nations will fear Him, seeing how He blesses those who fear Him.

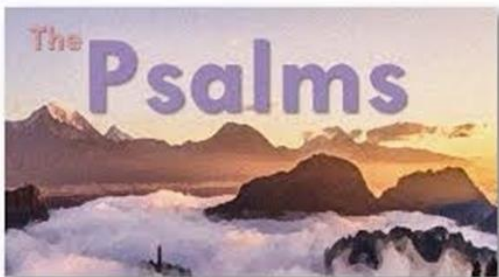
Question: Do you fear Adonai?

Day 12



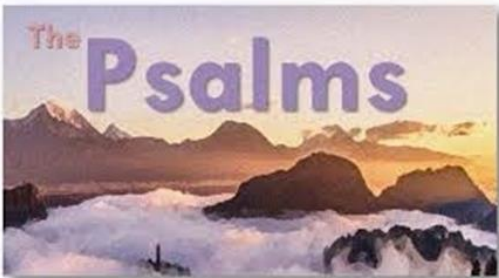
Book 2, Psalm 68 speaks of David, who is in danger, and asks for salvation from Adonai. He expresses his trust in Him.
