

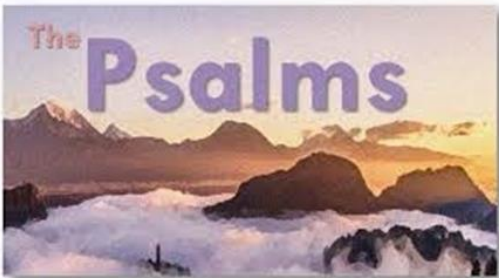
Day 16



Book 3, Psalm 79 speaks of Asaph praying to Adonai to withdraw from his anger after Jerusalem is invaded, and the sanctuary is defiled.
Question: How long, Adonai, will You be angry? Forever? Will Your jealousy keep blazing like fire?
Key: we, Your people, the flock of Your pasture, will praise You forever. From generation to generation we will recount Your praise.

Day 16



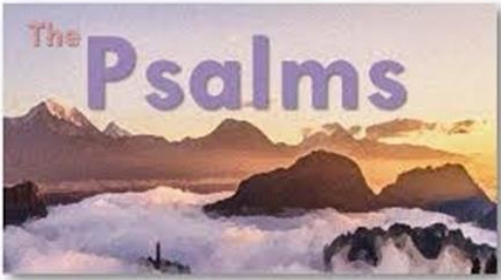
Book 3, Psalm 80 speaks of Asaph praying to Adonai to have mercy and restore the people of Israel.

Question: Adonai-Tzva'ot (Lord God Almighty), how long will You be angry with the prayer of Your people?

Key: You pulled out a vine from Egypt. You drove out nations and planted it.

Prayer: Abba, Elohei-Tzva'ot (God Almighty), please return! Look down from heaven and see! Now take care of this vine, Let Your hand be upon the man of Your right hand, the son of man You made strong for Yourself. Then we will not turn away from You. Revive us, and we will call on Your Name. Adonai Elohei-Tzva'ot, restore us. Make Your face shine, and we will be saved. In Yeshua's Mighty Name, Amen!

Book 3, Psalm 81 speaks of Asaph inviting the people of Israel to follow Adonai's precepts if they want to receive His blessing.

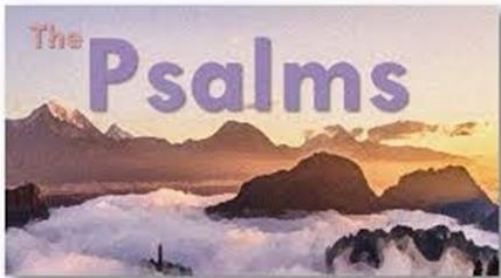
Question: Why don't we blow the shofar in the sanctuary anymore?

Day 16



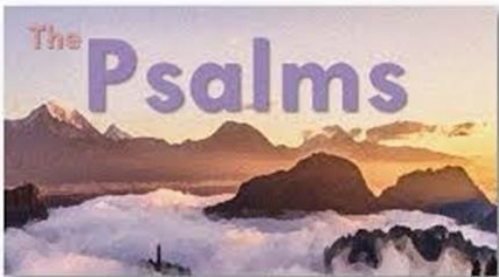
Book 3, Psalm 82 speaks of Asaph ranting against the unjust judges of Israel.
