Book 3, Psalm 88 speaks of a son of Korah shouting in anguish because sickness has struck his life, and he has been abandoned by friends and relatives.

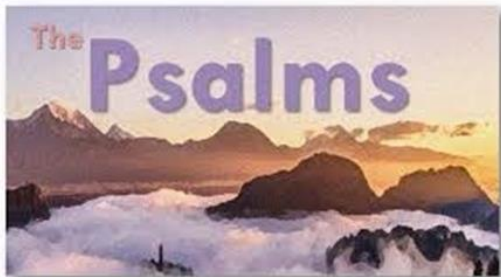

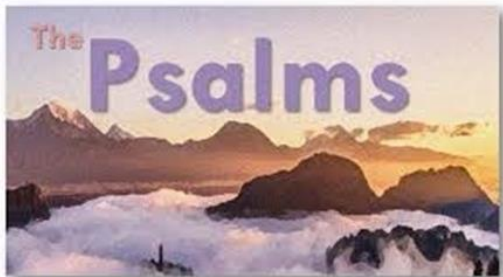
Question: For who in the skies can compare to Adonai? Who is like Him among the sons of gods? Who is like You, with Your faithfulness all around You?
