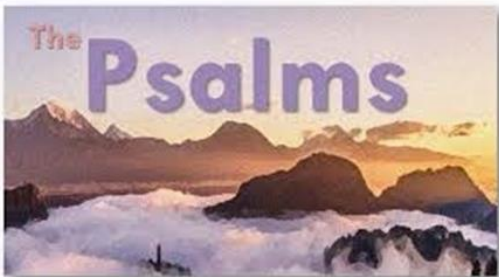
Question: Do you remember Adonai's precepts?
