Book 1 Psalm 35 speaks of David asking Adonai to give him justice over his enemies who are slandering him and waiting for his death.

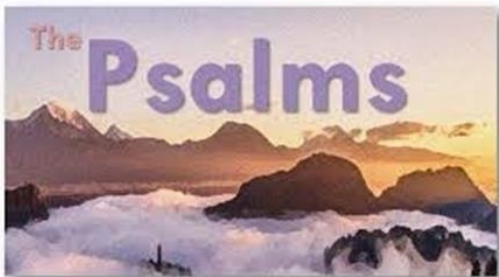
Question: "Adonai, who is like You, rescuing the poor from one too strong for him, the poor and needy from one who robs him?"

Day 6



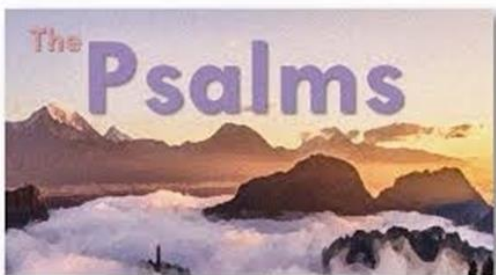
Book 1 Psalm 37 speaks of David who says not to be envious of the wicked whose happiness lasts for a short time.

Question: Do you trust in Adonai?

Key: Trust in Adonai and do good. Dwell in the land, feed on faithfulness.

Prayer: Abba, I trust in You and do good. I will dwell in the land, and feed on faithfulness. I will delight myself in You, and You will give me the requests of my heart. I will commit my ways to You, Adonai. I will trust in You, and You will do it. I will wait for You and keep Your ways, and You will exalt me to inherit the land. When the wicked are cut off, I will see it. Notice the man of integrity and watch the upright, for the man of shalom has a future. Adonai, help and deliver me. rescue me from the wicked and save me, because I take refuge in You. In Yeshua's Mighty Name, Amen!

Book 1 Psalm 38 speaks of David who is sick, and he confesses his sins to Adonai to receive forgiveness.

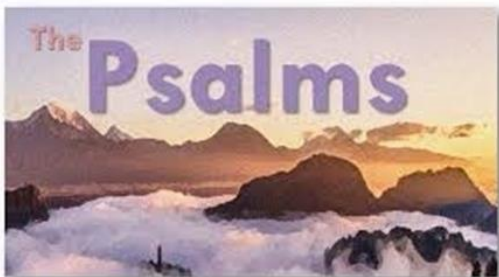
Question: Ask Adonai not to abandon you and not go far from you.
