Shalom dear Family and Friends in Moshiach,

Thank you for praying with us for peace in Israel over the past few weeks. We are grateful that the ceasefire announced on Friday, May 20th is continuing to hold and we are feeling a bit of calm after the storm in Israel.

Many of you have given to our Crisis in the [Middle East Emergency Fund in Israel](#) and we are so grateful that together with you and the Israeli Messianic Jewish Ministries, we stand with while we represent the hands and feet of Yeshua (Jesus) in the Land of Israel and the Diaspora. Thank you for your love for Israel and His People and care towards those affected by this crisis. While the main conflict in Israel seems to have quieted for the time being, devastating anti-Semitic attacks are on the rise across major cities around the world. This grieves us and the heart of Hashem (G-d) deeply. Racism is completely incompatible with following Yeshua (Jesus) the Messiah Teaching. And while all racism is evil, there is something different and more insidious about anti-Semitism.

Edward H. Flannery said, “Anti-Semitism is the longest and deepest hatred of human history.” Maybe you have wondered, “Why has there been such widespread Jew-hatred throughout history? And why have the Jewish people been singled out again and again?”

The Bible is clear: Hashem (G-d) loves both Israel and the Jewish people (Deut. 7:6-9; Jer. 31:3; Rom. 11:2, 29). Ultimately, anti-Semitism has one root cause—Satan. Israel plays a crucial role in Hashem (God)’s redemptive plan for the world. Therefore, the enemy seeks to thwart Hashem (God)’s plan by concentrating his efforts on destroying the Jewish people.

Satan’s plot became even darker when he began using Christianity as the vehicle to persecute the Jewish people. While Satan has failed to destroy the Jewish people, he has not failed to drive a wedge between Israel and the Gospel as a result of the cruelty of those who have gone by the name of “Christian.”

As a result, much of the Jewish world is reluctant to consider the claims of Yeshua (Jesus) as the Messiah. [Our efforts as believers to stand with the Jewish people against anti-Semitism, whenever and wherever it rises, give concrete expression to our belief that it was Hashem \(God\)’s choice to create a people for His glory and purposes.](#)

We know this is a complex moment in history and we are so grateful for your prayer and financial support. Yeshua (Jesus) is still on the throne. Our Shalom (peace) and hope come from Him alone.

Village of Hope & Justice Ministry does not conduct covert missionary activity. Our organization and our teachings are well known. Our identity as a Messianic Jewish organization is stated in all our materials. We are open and public about what we do: providing Messianic Jewish Teaching and Counseling to Gentiles and Jews for over ten years.

We denounce evangelism and proselytizing, especially when any deception is involved. Instead, like any movement with an ideology, we engage in discussion and hope that more people will see things our way. Our goal is not to win over converts to our creed but to influence society through reasoned, intellectually honest, and mutually respectful dialogue.

Our staff members always openly explain to our visitors upfront that it is a Messianic Jewish Ministry, so there would be no confusion. Everyone is welcome in our Ministry!

Most of our efforts are directed toward both Gentiles and Jews. Our goal is to combat Gentiles (Christian) anti-Semitism and replacement theology, also to represent Messianic Judaism in Italy through the newly founded [Italian Messianic Jewish Alliance](#) in the will of peaceful dialogue and [reconciliation between the Jews and the Gentiles in Hashem's will against Anti-Semitism](#). In our view, eradicating those harmful Gentiles (Christian) views requires educating them on the Jewishness of Yeshua (Jesus) and the unchanging truth of the Torah.

In contrast to historical Christianity, but in concert with modern scholarship, we believe and teach that Yeshua (Jesus) upheld the Torah and Hashem (God)'s unique covenant with the Jewish people. In keeping with this perspective, we promote faithfulness to the Torah and a Jewish lifestyle for all Jewish people, whether they believe in Yeshua (Jesus) or not.

As a Messianic Jewish Ministry, we are officially registered in Italy as a non-profit organization. Messianic Jews are often not welcome in typical synagogues or churches. We are not ashamed to provide a home and a place for them where they can worship in keeping with their convictions. Our Messianic Synagogues welcome Jews and Gentiles.

In a free society, any law-abiding spiritual community has a right to exist, conduct worship services as they see fit, and educate their members on how to live. We are hopeful our contemporary society in Israel and the diaspora will not tolerate an attack on the freedom of religion in the most religiously diverse place on earth, Israel, also in the diaspora.

We are not shy or embarrassed about our message to the world, both to Gentiles (Christians) and Jews. If you wish to know what we really believe and teach, our materials are widely available through our website. We hope that by understanding Yeshua (Jesus) as a Jew, we can begin to move past baseless hatred and heal the painful divide between Gentiles (Christians) and Jews as we are called to be ministers of reconciliation in the Moshiach.
